The Center for Fiscal Accountability urges all Members of the United States House of Representatives to vote YES on Sen. DeMint’s amendment #2410 to the Transportation, Housing, Urban Development and Related Agencies Appropriations bill.

After taxpayers have been asked to bear the burden of several costly government bailouts and a failed trillion dollar spending and debt package, Congress should refrain from wasting tax dollars on pork projects.

The DeMint amendment strikes funding (other than for air traffic control operations) for one of the most notable earmarks in the country, the John Murtha Airport, which has received over \$200 million in taxpayers’ money over the last 20 years. The airport sees no more than 20 passengers a day and only provides three commercial flights a day (all of which go to Washington D.C) and recently made headlines after being awarded a significant sum of “stimulus” funds in spite of the fact that the airport is largely unused.
